Genetec's Security Center 5.0 Supports Bosch G Series Control Panels

Users can arm and disarm panels manually via the Security Center user interface, or automatically via scheduled tasks and in response to security events. Operators can also run reports to view alarm panels' events and alarms. Through Genetec's Federation feature, Bosch intrusion panels integrated within remote Security Center installations can be federated back to an organization's headquarters or central offices, allowing operators to run intrusion reports across dozens or hundreds of remote sites.

The Security Center allows users to associate video cameras to intrusion zones and alarms, thereby providing operators with the ability to perform video verification of intrusion alarms prior to dispatching security personnel or local law enforcement. On the configuration front, the Security Center will automatically discover a Bosch intrusion panel's configuration and enrol the panel and its settings including partition and zone information, thereby making the intrusion device enrolment process as seamless and efficient as possible.
